






Automatic operation

Want to open and close your sliding door easily and conveniently from your sofa? Selected models come with Schüco TipTronic, linked to the Schüco Building Skin Control platform. With this solution, you can effortlessly move even large-scale sliding vents that weigh up to 600 kg using your tablet, smartphone, language assistant or a switch. An integrated anti-finger-trap device stops the sliding vent automatically if any kind of obstacle is detected when moving, such as a child's hand.

Schüco SmartClose

It's a familiar feature in modern kitchens: doors and cupboards that close silently, almost by themselves. Schüco sliding doors use similar technology. With Schüco SmartClose, an innovative soft-closing mechanism slows down the moving vent gently but effectively and moves it automatically into the closed end position. You can then manually lock the sliding door using the handle.

Attractive sun shading

The textile Schuco sun shading system AB ZA (Aluminium Blind ZIP Adapted) protects against disruptive sunlight. Its wide units offer optimum shading for even the largest Schüco Design sliding doors. The zip technology ensures a smooth fabric appearance with a lean and modern design. Depending on the material and fabric openness coefficient (0-14%), you get an opaque textile that provides superb glare protection and screening or a transparent fabric that ensures a perfect view to the outside. And depending on type, Schüco Design sliding doors can also be combined with all conventional shading solutions such as external blinds or shutters.

Slimline face widths

If you choose a large-scale sliding door, you want a view that is unlimited. In order to ensure that this is impacted as little as possible by profiles, Schüco Design sliding doors have particularly slimline frames, some of which disappear completely into the floor, walls and ceilings with guides. Panorama Design sliding doors are the number one when it comes to a great view. All you can see is the narrow interlock section (up to 31 mm) between the vent units. Although Schüco Classic Design sliding doors do not vanish into the walls and floor, they can still provide a great view with slimline face widths of as small as 40 mm in the interlock section, depending on the design.

Designer handles

A great design is consistent down to the last detail – and that includes the handle. That's why we've developed a range of handles that fit seamlessly into the design of the Schüco sliding doors with a harmonious look that also matches our windows.

Individual colour choices

Brilliant white, on-trend grey or a subtle natural finish? It's up to you. We offer a great range of colour and coating options for the profiles of your Schüco Design sliding door. One highlight of our PVC-U sliding doors is Schüco AutomotiveFinish, which makes great use of knowledge from the automotive paint industry. Burglars love sliding doors. They seem to assume that large glass units and slimline profiles make breaking in easier. Wrong! Here at Schüco, we really believe that you should feel safe and secure at home. That's why our Design sliding doors come complete with tested and certified burglar resistance.

Security is more than a feeling at Schüco - it's a certified assurance! Uninvited guests stay outside - even though general break-in figures have been high for years.

Better safe than sorry

Schüco Design sliding doors keep your home secure in many different ways. The glass units are fixed in place continuously, installed in vent frames with anti-lift-out devices and have additional locking points in multiple areas between the vent units. Handles with lock/push buttons also increase burglar resistance. They are easy to retrofit.

Burglar resistance up to RC 3

If it takes burglars longer than one minute to gain access to a building, many of them give up. The risk of being caught is too high. Our products comply with at resistance class RC 2 at a minimum, as recommended by the police, and keep burglars busy for around three minutes. In general: the higher the resistance class, the safer. Security levels for private homes range from RC 1N (basic protection) to RC 3 (high protection).

KfW support

The KfW [German Credit Institute for Reconstruction] promotes the installation of burglar-resistant windows and doors. Alongside a grant (KfW 455-E), you can also apply for low-interest credit (credit KfW 159). Go to www.kfw.de to find out more.

App-controlled

Schüco TipTronic technology combined with the Schüco Building Skin Control platform enables integrated opening and closing monitoring for your sliding door. No matter where you are, you can use an app to check if your sliding door is open or closed and locked. You can also combine the monitoring system with alarm systems in order to further increase the safety of your house and family.

Safe and sound

Schüco Design sliding doors not only protect against uninvited guests, but also against weather, injury and noise: for example, they can be locked at any opening width you want in order to provide safe ventilation while also stopping them slamming open or shut due to wind or storms. This can also stop small children getting their fingers crushed. Optimum sound insulation ensures a peaceful living atmosphere, even if there is a very busy road nearby (for example).

This means it can be returned into the material cycle as often as you want. PVC-U is also easily recyclable and can be broken down into its constituent parts and reused without problems.


We ensure maximum efficiency by setting high standards for the thermal insulation of our products. Our Design sliding doors are real energy-savers that can attain passive house standard, irrespective of the materials used. This not only reduces heating costs, but also ensures a comfortable living climate.

High quality ensures long life

Schüco Design sliding doors use fantastic high-quality materials. The longer our products are in use, the better their environmental impact – making them a wise investment in economic terms too. The technology for long-term use is tested at the Schüco Technology Center. A long service life is only guaranteed when the sliding door can pass the endurance test of up to 20,000 opening and closing cycles.

On our own test bench

The Schüco Technology Center is one of the highest-performing test centres for windows, doors and façades worldwide – and the largest in Europe. Over 40 employees carry out several hundred tests a year here, from small components to complete façade units. Our new Design sliding doors are also put under the microscope in the Technology Center. Mechanical and safety aspects play a particularly important part in tests.





ting new things every day with the weather making everything different every time.



Interview

THE ARCHITECTS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE PROJECT, MICHAŁ BARYŻEWSKI AND ZBIGNIEW RESZKA FROM ARCH-DECO, DISCUSS INDIVIDUALITY, STYLE AND EXQUISITE POSITION.

What makes the connection between villa and landscape so special?

The complex was embedded into the hill to highlight the sea view. The most important thing for us was for the building to make use of the natural hillside location of the property, in order to ensure much-needed privacy from the road side while also opening up the interior for the best possible view of the bay.

What was the idea behind the building concept?

It's meant to be a family house – all year round, through all the seasons, no matter what the weather. This trilogy of indoor areas, roofed outdoor areas and entirely outdoor areas with varying sizes helps blur the boundaries between inside and outside. They create a connected space that you simply don't want to leave.

You decided to use Schüco sliding doors as part of this...

Yes, definitely. Firstly, the air quality in this region is incredible, which is why we decided to use sliding doors in the first place. Furthermore, the Schüco Panorama Design sliding doors enabled us to open up the indoor areas to nature – even when they're actually closed. The open corner solution was a great idea for the pool pavilion. It gives the swimmers a view of the bay and can be opened up to the outside in the summer.

ago, the family was still sitting in their red brick house, tinkering with construction plans for the house of their dreams. They were in agreement on one thing: although they were already living in the perfect place with a perfect view, the unspoilt vistas of sea and countryside were simply too amazing to be looked at through ordinary windows. They wanted more. To see more, feel more, enjoy more. A view of the horizon, even from inside the house. And so the building project began in 2016: a villa with a view with the focus on open architecture. The build followed a clear vision: to bring together the location, the lighting mood at different times of year and the functionality required for the 6-strong family into a cohesive whole. Working with the Lorenzen architectural studio, the Tarpgaards' dream became reality in 2020. The architecture is deliberately closed off on the road side with a continuous wall, creating the necessary private space. However, on the sea side, the entire length of the villa opens up to the Baltic Sea and the living spaces merge visually with the landscape. Large Schüco Classic Design sliding doors and façade systems provide maximum transparency here. You will never get tired of seeing the sun glint on the sea or watching the wild autumn storms stirring up the water. The Tarpgaards often find themselves gazing out to sea – as far as the eye can see. And that's when Line and Martin know that they've done everything right.






to create for his family. And he's done it with the "Black Lodge".



And there's one thing he's certain about: "My grandfather would have felt right at home here too." Because even if the house has completely changed after the renovation, one thing remains the same: the view of the spectacular mountain scenery.






